GS TECH Career Path Plan

MENTORING

Who better to learn from than a certified automobile technician? For one full day, every two weeks, you will work hand in hand with the best technicians learning world technical skills and practical experience necessary to the real give you confidence and be successful. On mentoring days you will not be doing your normal work responsibilities. We will monitor what you have learned and seek your feedback on your mentoring.

AC DELCO TRAINING

Everyday you will be given time for training. One half will be committed to the AC Delco training or The Hunter Alignment training.

ASE TRAINING

DAE will reimburse you for the cost of testing for each ASE certification passed by you. Also, a \$75 credit will be add the \$2,000 tool box program for each ASE Certification passed

TOOL BOX PROGRAM

DAE wants to help GS Techs to get started building a toolbox. For each month of tenure after becoming a certified State Inspector, DAE will contribute a 1/12th credit toward a \$2000 set of tools. The first month that counts toward the toolbox is the first FULL calendar month worked by a GS Tech after becoming SI certified.

For example, if a GS Tech came to work on February 15 and then got SI certified on March 20th, the first month that would be eligible for the 1/12th credit toward this program would be April.
